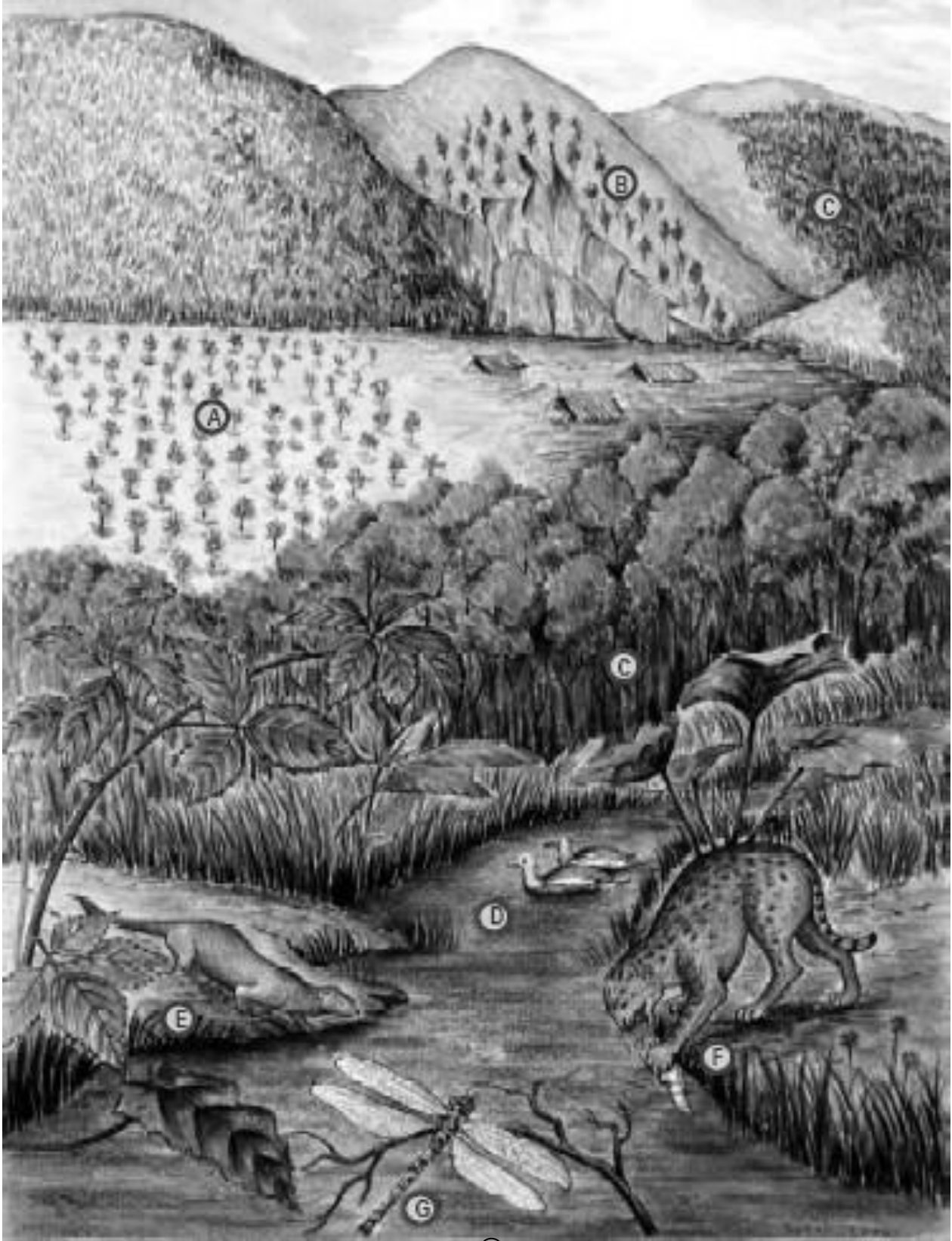




Planting to Maximise Conservation



Important places in the landscape for planting:

- (A) wildlife corridors between forest areas
- (B) where the risk of soil erosion or landslides is high
- (C) along water courses

Water courses are essential for the survival of specialized wildlife such as White-winged Wood-duck (D) otters (E) Fishing Cat (F) and dragonflies (G)
